
The preference of the stakeholder and favorite of the Committee was LC-O-02, a realistic portrait of Lions Clubs founder Melvin Jones, augmented by the universally recognized Lions Clubs logo.



The Committee felt this obverse was best paired with LC-R-05a, featuring a pair of lions set against a globe, symbolic of Lions Clubs' world-wide reach in their mission to aid the blind and visually impaired.
