Dear Secretary Lew:

A public meeting of the Citizens Coinage Advisory Committee (Committee) was held on Monday, March 11, 2013, at United States Mint Headquarters in Washington, DC. The Committee reviewed proposed reverse designs for the 2014 National Baseball Hall of Fame Commemorative Coin Program inclusive of a \$5 gold coin, \$1 silver dollar and clad half dollar.

For the program's common reverse, the Committee recommended design HOF-02A. The design, which garnered 17 of the 21 possible points through the Committee's scoring process, depicts a baseball with the inscription, "United States of America", shown above the denominational indicator (i.e. Five Dollars, One Dollar or Half Dollar).
